Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter is to notify you that the COVID-19 Dashboard has been updated with new information that has been reported to the district. Please note the following additions to the dashboard.

**High School** - December 13 – A student that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms on the evening of December 10 tested negative for COVID-19. With the negative test, close contacts can end quarantine and return to school. Close contacts were informed.

**High School** - December 13 – A GRHS staff member tested positive for COVID-19 on December 9. The staff member was last in the building on December 4. There is no need to contact trace since the staff member was last in the building on December 4. No change to the HS/MS schedule.

**Middle School** - December 13 - A student that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms on December 10 tested negative for COVID-19. With the negative test, close contacts can end quarantine and return to school. Close contacts were informed.

**Middle School** - December 13 - A student that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms on December 9 tested negative for COVID-19. With the negative test, close contacts can end quarantine and return to school. Close contacts were informed.

**Central** - December 13 – A Central Elementary staff member exhibited COVID-19 symptoms yesterday. The staff member will need to get a COVID-19 test. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine until the staff member receives results of the test. Contact tracing complete. No change to the AM/PM schedule.

As shared above, the appropriate contact tracing has been completed and all affected parties were informed. In addition, the local health officer, the school doctor and other officials were notified as well.
