This letter is to notify you that the COVID-19 Dashboard has been updated with new information that has been reported to the district. Please note the following additions to the dashboard.

Central School - January 11 – A Central Staff member tested for COVID-19 on January 9. The staff member was last in the building on January 7. Close contacts were informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete.

January 11 - Two (2) Central Elementary students that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms were sent home today. The students will need to get a COVID-19 test prior to returning to school. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete.

High School - January 11 – One (1) GRHS student that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms was sent home today. The student will need to get a COVID-19 test prior to returning to school. Close contacts were identified and informed to guarantine. Contact tracing complete.

January 11 – One (1) GRHS student exhibited COVID-19 symptoms on January 9. The student was last in the building on January 8. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete.

Middle School - January 11 – Two (2) GRMS students from the same household tested positive for COVID-19 on January 7. The students received the results of the test on January 9. The students were last in the building prior to winter break. No contact tracing required.

Hamilton School - January 11 – Two (2) Hamilton students that exhibited COVID-19 symptoms were sent home today. The students will need to get a COVID-19 test prior to returning to school. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete.

Coleman School - January 11 – One Coleman student tested positive for COVID-19 for January 7. The student received the result of the test on January 9. The student was last in the building prior to winter break. No contact tracing required.

Community School - January 11 – One (1) Community School staff member exhibited COVID-19 symptoms on January 8. The staff will need to get a COVID-19 test prior to returning to school. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete.
