Participants To-Do List

1. Fill out the top half of the form
2. Sign up **at least one sponsor**
3. Read your books during the month of March and record all minutes read in and out of school
4. Show your reading log to your sponsor(s) and collect your pledge money
5. Submit your entry online or via the paper form with the help of your parent/guardian by **April 9th** at: <https://forms.gle/vJPB8DypLum5BvReA> or drop off at school or library
6. Receive your medal at your school or at the library in early June (see below how to qualify)
7. **For every book you read that incorporates diversity, you can collect diversity points for your school/grade! Check out <https://forms.gle/sidZ3c7zSs1Gvxew8> to enter *during the month of March*.**

All☆Star Reader Medals

To receive a medal and be counted towards the school and grade total and special recognition, you must:

- ✓ include a pledge with a minimum of **\$5** (online verification code is your proof)
- ✓ read **in and out** of school (see table)

Grade	Total Reading Time
Preschool	150 min (5 mins a day)
Kindergarten & Grade 1	300 min (10 mins a day)
Grade 2 and Grade 3	450 min (15 mins a day)
Grade 4 and Grade 5	600 min (20 mins a day)

Special Town Recognition Categories

- ★ Gold Level Reader(s) must meet the goal of 4,500 minutes read
- ★ Gold Level Fundraiser(s) must raise \$150 per participant or \$250 per family
- ★ School with the highest participation

Special School Recognition Categories

- ★ Silver Level Reader(s) must meet the goal of 3,600 minutes read
- ★ Grade with the highest participation
- ★ School/grade with the highest percentage of diversity points.

The Friends of the Glen Rock Public Library hosts the annual Readathon to encourage children to read and use the library. The Readathon also raises funds for Children's Room materials, programs and services, such as computers, software, audio visual supplies, guest artists and storytellers. **The popular summer reading program is fully funded by funds raised through the Readathon.** If you have questions, please stop by or call the Library Children's Room (201-670-3973).
