Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter is to notify you that the COVID-19 Dashboard has been updated with new information that has been reported to the district. Please note the following additions to the dashboard.

**Coleman** - March 8 – One (1) Coleman staff member tested positive for COVID-19 on March 3. The staff member was last in the building on March 5. The staff member received results of the positive test on March 6. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete. Coleman will be on a virtual AM/PM schedule through March 19 and return to in person instruction on March 22.

**High School** - March 8 – One (1) GRHS student tested positive for COVID-19 on March 4. The student was last in the building on March 2. Close contacts were identified and informed to quarantine. Contact tracing complete. No change to the HS/MS Hybrid schedule.

*UPDATE:* Letter from March 4, 2021 should have reflected the following: March 4 - One (1) GRHS student tested positive for COVID-19 on February 25. The student was last in the building on February 5. The district was notified of the positive test on March 4. There is no need for contact tracing since the student has not been in the building since February 5. No change to the High School Hybrid schedule.

**Middle School** - March 8 – One (1) GRMS student tested positive for COVID-19 on March 5. The student was last in the building on March 1. No contact tracing needed as the student was last in the building on March 1. No change to the HS/MS Hybrid schedule.

As shared above, the appropriate contact tracing has been completed and all affected parties were informed. In addition, the local health officer, the school doctor and other officials were notified as well.
