Holocaust Education: Mrs. Wechtler's English 9 classes had a Zoom w/ Paul Galan, Holocaust Survivor on March 10th. Students in Mrs. Wechtler's 9th grade classes read *Night* and studied about the Holocaust. One of the major goals of the unit was to understand the stories of Holocaust survivors. Mr. Galan spoke openly about his experiences as a young child. He shared his true hopes for young people to do good in the world and reminded us all to continue to carry hope in our hearts and minds. This is the first year that our team has placed in the Top Ten for the Division – twice. Glen Rock fifth graders Kadence Chang and Itamar Lahav earned a perfect score of 20 in the recent meet. Nationally, only 39 students achieved this result. Congrats to Madilyn Olenick for her almost perfect score of 19.
